John 17:20-21

Introduction:

- 1. When the New Testament speaks of the church, it speaks of the saved body of Christ.
- 2. Our purpose will be to distinguish the simple New Testament church from the secularized version of it and to present the church as it is biblically defined.

Discussion:

- I. The Secular Modern Church.
- II. The Simple New Testament Church.
- III. Accepting the Truth.

Conclusion:

- 1. The church of Christ is not a secular institution. It is the saved body of Christ everywhere.
- 2. All of the saved are members of the universal body of Christ.
- 3. Sinners are added to that universal church when, by faith in Christ, they obey that form of teaching.
- 4. A group of people become a New Testament church when they obey the law of pardon and are inducted into the body of Christ, and then unite together for work and worship.
